



# MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURE FOR CANADIAN VISA APPLICANTS

## LIST OF REQUIREMENTS

- 1 **The Medical Report Form (IMM 1017E)** sent by the IRCC that requires the client to undergo medical exam **except** for applicants who are undergoing Upfront Medical Exam  
*\*Applicants under the **Upfront Medical Exam** (those who have not received the Medical Report form IMM 1017E) will be provided with an Information Sheet generated from the eMedical.*
- 2 **Valid passport** and a **photocopy of the bio page**
- 3 **National ID Card or a Government-issued ID** for the clinic and Trafalgar building access pass

## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

### For Minor Applicants (0-18 yrs. old)

- 1 Kindly bring **PSA Birth certificate** and a photocopy
- Minor applicants accompanied by the parent**
  - 1 Parent to bring **two (2) valid Government-issued IDs** for the clinic and Trafalgar building access pass
- Minor applicants accompanied by a guardian (not the parent)**
  - 1 **Letter of Authorization** from the minor's parent (signed) and a scanned copy of the parent's passport.  
*\*The Letter of Authorization can be scanned and then emailed to the guardian by the parent. The guardian can print the said document and bring it on the day of the minor's appointment*
  - 2 **valid Government-issued IDs** of the guardian for the clinic and Trafalgar building access pass

### For Pregnant Applicants

Prior to taking a chest x-ray (CXR), it is highly recommended that you consult with your Obstetrician who is in the best position to give advise on your individual medical status. All pregnant clients after being counseled by the MHC

Panel Physicians can decide on either of these two options:

- Continue CXR examination with double shielding, after signing the pregnancy waiver.
- Defer the CXR because of the pregnancy in full understanding that the IME will be placed on hold, and can only be finalized until the CXR is done.

### For applicants who have been vaccinated

- 1 Kindly bring your **vaccination card** on the day of your appointment.

Important Reminders:

\*If applicants have significant medical history or undergoing treatment, kindly bring pertinent medical reports/results.

\*Please bring your eye glasses or contact lens, if applicable.

\*No fasting is required. No specimen samples should be brought.
