



JAPAN PRE-ENTRY TUBERCULOSIS SCREENING

LIST OF REQUIREMENTS

- ① **Actual and valid PASSPORT and a photocopy of the bio page**

*Must be valid for at least six (6) months.

- ② **One (1) government-issued ID** e.g. Voter's ID, PRC, LTO driver's license, SSS/GSIS UMID Card or National ID for the Trafalgar building access pass.
- ③ Request for JPETS (if available).

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

For Applicant 0-18 yrs. old

- ① Kindly bring **PSA Birth certificate** and photocopy.

Minor applicants accompanied by the parent

- ① Parent to bring two (2) valid Government-issued IDs for the clinic and Trafalgar building access pass.

Minor applicants accompanied by a guardian (not the parent)

- ① **Letter of Authorization** from the minor's parent (signed) and a scanned copy of the parent's passport.
- ② **2 valid Government-issued IDs** of the guardian for the clinic and Trafalgar building access pass.

For Pregnant Applicants

- ① Prior to taking a chest x-ray (CXR), it is highly recommended that you consult with your Obstetrician who is in the best position to give advice on your individual medical status. All pregnant clients after being counseled by the MHC Panel Physician can decide on either of these options:

1. Postpone the CXR until after delivery
2. Continue with CXR with double shielding, after signing a consent form and waiver. Kindly secure a clearance from your obstetrician allowing you to proceed with the x-ray and present it on the day of your appointment.

*Regardless of the options, the Pregnant Applicant will be counselled and an Informed Consent must be obtained.

Pregnant Applicant with CXR within the last 3 months

*As a special measure, if a pregnant woman has undergone CXR within the last 3 months at the same Panel Clinic in which she is currently receiving TB screening, the previous CXR may be used for clearance purposes provided that she meets both of the following conditions:

- (1) she has no signs or symptoms of TB, and
- (2) she has had no close contact with an active pulmonary TB patient within the past 2 years.

Important Reminders:

*Applicants with TB medical history or undergoing TB treatment or had any pulmonary disease/s in the past, kindly bring pertinent medical reports/results.

*No specimen samples should be brought.
