Important Reminders

- Additional health examinations and specialist's referral might be requested where considered appropriate on clinical grounds according to specific health condition that is identified during your initial health examinations or as part of the visa application process.
- If chest X-ray is abnormal, presenting changes suggestive of an active or inactive TB process or if there are other clinical reasons to suspect TB disease, the applicant will be referred for sputum testing. No additional charges will apply.
- If applicant is tested positive for active TB, he/she will undergo TB treatment under IOM supervision. Follow up diagnostics (Chest Xray and sputum testing) shall be done in IOM with no additional charges.

Important Notes

- 1 If at least one family member is referred for sputum tests, active close household contact tracing might be necessary.
- 2 No fasting is required.
 - No any specimen samples to be brought.
