



MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURE FOR CANADIAN VISA APPLICANTS

LIST OF REQUIREMENTS

- 1 The **Medical Report Form (IMM 1017E)** sent by the Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC/IRCC) that requires the client to undergo medical exam **except** for applicants who are undergoing **Upfront Medical Exam**
*For applicants undergoing Upfront Medical Exam, (those who have not received the Medical Report form), IOM will issue applicants a document generated from the eMedical electronic system as proof that you have complied with the medical requirements.
- 2 **Valid passport and a photocopy of the Bio Page**
- 3 **Two (2) Government-issued IDs** e.g. Voter's ID, PRC, LTO driver's license, SSS/GSIS UMID Card
*One for the clinic and the other for the building security at the Ground Flr.)

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

For applicants who have been vaccinated, kindly bring your vaccination cards to be presented on the day of your appointment. However, please note that COVID-19 vaccination is not a prerequisite to your medical exam.

For Applicants 0-18 yrs. old:

- 1 Kindly bring **PSA Birth certificate** and if available, a **School ID** for the current school year and photocopies

Minor applicants to be accompanied by a guardian:

- 1 **Letter of Authorization** from the parent sponsoring the visa application (signed) and a scanned copy of the parent's passport
*These documents can be scanned and then emailed to the guardian by the parent. Guardian can print said documents and bring it on the day of the minor's medical exam.
- 2 **2 valid Government-issued IDs** of the guardian (for the clinic and building security)

For Pregnant Applicants:

Prior to taking a chest x-ray (CXR), it is highly recommended that you consult with your Obstetrician who is in the best position to give advise on your individual medical status. All pregnant clients after being counseled by the MHC Panel Physicians can decide on either of these two options:

- Continue CXR examination with double shielding, after signing the pregnancy waiver.
- Defer the CXR because of the pregnancy in full understanding that the IME will be placed on hold, and can only be finalized until the CXR is done.

Important Reminders:

- *If applicants have significant medical history or undergoing treatment, kindly bring pertinent medical reports/results.
- *Please bring your eye glasses or contact lens, if applicable.
- *No fasting is required. No specimen samples should be brought.
